Getting to Kyoto Seika University



RAIL ACCESS

Eizan Electric Railway - Kurama Line (Platform 2 or 3 from Demachi-Yanagi, approx. 20 minutes, ¥320). SEIKA's stop is Kyoto Seika Dai-mae, the university's own station, on the west side of campus.

SUBWAY ACCESS

Karasuma Line to Kokusai-kaikan (from Kyoto, approx. 20 minutes, ¥280)

Free Shuttle Bus runs between the station and SEIKA.

From Exit No.3, turn right (towards Mt. Hiei) and cross the small side street, and you will soon see the shuttle bus stop, marked by a blue sign.
